

Rochester High School Scholarships

King Anness Memorial Scholarship Fund: For Rochester High School graduates with preference given to students deserving financial assistance.

Paul and Dorothy Arven Memorial Scholarship: For the study of nursing or agriculture.

Elizabeth V. Babcock Scholarship: Educational scholarship support for those eligible, who are graduates of Rochester High

Jim Barkman Memorial Scholarship: For those who attended Riddle Elementary School at any time.

Brent L. Blacketer Memorial Scholarship: Must have attended RHS at least 2 years. Demonstrate academic ability, leadership, service ; good character; citizenship; need; probability of success.

Blacktop Cruisers—Earl Gaerte Scholarship: For those entering the automotive technology field.

Zelma Crabill-Helen and Carl Wilson Scholarship: Plan to attend an accredited college, university, trade or vocational school. Preference is given to those who are pursuing health care or agriculture degrees.

The W.D. Cumberland 4-H Scholarship: For 9 to 10 year 4-H members; 4 year Beef Member, 4 year Livestock Member or 4 year Jr. Leader.

Herb Davidson Memorial Athletic Scholarship: For those students who participated in high school basketball and football; deserving of financial assistance.

Simon Deeb Scholarship: Provides agricultural educational scholarships for RHS students.

Dale Eizinger and Robert Tobey Agricultural Scholarship Fund: Preference given to students studying agriculture or horticulture field.

Joan Ruth Ewing Scholarship Fund: For students pursuing a degree in education

RB Fear Agricultural Scholarship: Must be in upper 50% of graduating class and plan to attend Purdue University.

Frounfelter Scholarship: For students in the top 20% of their class who attended RHS for at least 4 years, have a "B" average. Those with a "full-ride" scholarship are not considered.

Melissa Hoffman Gamel Scholarship: Must show academic accomplishment, be active and involved in school, work and the community and have an interest in the study of engineering and technology

Jayne Ann Good Memorial Scholarship: Preference given to a female student who has participated in a high school sport and plans to attend an accredited college, university, or trade school. Scholarship is renewable for up to 4years

Roy Haggerty Memorial Scholarship: For those who plan to be full-time students at Indiana University Bloomington or other Indiana University campus.

Elmer Harris & Beulah P. Harris Scholarship: Union Township residents who plan to attend trade school or college.

Franklin and Jane Heisler and David Heisler Memorial Scholarship: For those attending an accredited college, university, trade or vocational school in Indiana also online programs or studies.

Mark Howdeshell Memorial Scholarship: For those who plan to study engineering or a medical field. 1st generation students given special consideration.

Kewanna Schools Memorial Scholarship: Graduating seniors of Rochester, Caston or Winamac high school. Preference will be given to Union Township residents. Minimum 3.0 GPA (4.0 scale), involved in athletics and other extra-curricular activities.

Angele J. Kochenderfer Memorial Scholarship: For hearing impaired students. If no hearing-impaired student applies, those who plan to study in the field of educating the hearing-impaired are considered.

Harold E. and Neva Funk Mikesell Scholarship: For students who reside in Aubbeenaubbee Township who plan to attend an Indiana college, university, business or trade schools.

David Ewing McCarter Memorial Scholarship: For graduating seniors of Rochester High School who have participated in a minimum of 2 sports for 4 years.

Jayson McCalla Memorial Scholarship: For those who plan to attend any Indiana 2, 3 or 4 year accredited college, university or trade school. Those who participated in baseball are given preference.

Coach John Robert McKee Memorial Scholarship: For those who participated in Rochester High School Football or Rochester High School Wrestling.

John R. Nelson Memorial Scholarship: Must reside in Aubbeenaubbee Township and maintain a "B" average and plan to major in the field of education and teaching.

Nick Patterson Scholarship: Must have participated in and competed in one varsity sport their senior year; have a GPA of at least a 2.0. Those who are planning on entering the military are given some preference.

Greg Peter Memorial Fund: For those pursuing a degree in the arts and/or HVAC education at an accredited college, university, trade or vocational school and have been involved in the community.

Rochester Firefighters' Memorial Scholarship: Financial need, scholastic achievement, active in school, work and the community. Special consideration to children of employees of fire, EMS, police or sheriff departments.

Rochester High School Memorial Scholarship: Contact the high school.

Nelson W. Sadler Memorial Ag Scholarship: For those pursuing an education in an agricultural related field at a college, university or trade school.

George M. Schwenk Memorial Scholarship: For qualified students who are interested in the study of agriculture or a related field of study.

Lawrence J & Violet M. Seiwert Scholarship: For graduating seniors who have attended RHS 4 continuous years prior to graduation, GPA, financial need and involvement in work, school and community.

Union Township Scholarship: For Union Township residents who show academic accomplishment, financial need, involvement in school, work and the community.

Arlene Webb cosmetology School Scholarship: For the study of Cosmetology.

Dr. Russell L. and Pauline Whittenberger Sparks Memorial Scholarship: For graduating seniors of who have attended RHS for at least 2 academic years.
