

Statement of Speech and Hearing Scholarship

The Eta Mu Chapter of Psi Iota Xi Sorority offers a Speech and Hearing Scholarship of up to \$2000 to a graduating senior majoring in speech and hearing. If no senior in the graduating class pursues a major in speech and hearing, former graduates majoring in the field of speech and hearing will be considered.

The money will be placed in a scholarship savings account. The recipient must complete the freshman and sophomore years of college before receiving the scholarship. The recipient should then contact Jennifer Snyder at (574) 223-2176 ext. 4114 or jennifer.snyder@zebras.net.

Then, the recipient will provide a copy of his/her college transcript to the scholarship chairwoman and must still be majoring in speech and hearing. The scholarship chairwoman will then be responsible for confirming that all requirements have been met and see that the recipient is awarded the money.

Students applying for this scholarship must have the application submitted to the high school guidance office by February 9, 2018.

The following information should be included:

1. High school transcript with grade point average, class rank, and SAT scores
2. Resume including:
 - a. College or university planning to attend
 - b. Accomplishments and experiences in the area of speech and hearing
 - c. Parent's occupation(s) and place(s) of employment
 - d. Extracurricular activities and hobbies
 - e. Employment record
 - f. Educational goals and objectives
 - g. Additional information as desired
3. Two recommendations:
 - a. One from a speech and hearing specialist or someone in the medical field
 - b. One of the applicant's choosing (i.e. guidance counselor, principal, teacher, community member, etc)

The applications will be given careful consideration and be evaluated by the Scholarship Committee. All information submitted by the applicant will be kept confidential. The decision concerning the recipient of the scholarship will be made by a committee and announced during the Honors Night Program.
