## **College Courses offered on line with Indiana University Kokomo**

### **On Campus IU Kokomo Courses**

We have a couple of school districts who bus or allow students to come to campus during part of their school day to take IU Kokomo courses. Students enroll in 100 & 200 level courses that are typically part of the Core Transfer Library. Cost is \$125/credit hour after IU Kokomo provides a scholarship for about 50%. If you're interested in this model, we would need to know the days and times your students are available to come to campus. We would then share a course list to choose from. Final course selections would need to be identified by **March 15<sup>th</sup>**. We love this opportunity as it exposes high school students to a more realistic college classroom experience. IU Kokomo would host your students for an orientation session covering college expectations, purchasing books, and learning the needed technology.

### **IU Kokomo Online courses**

\$125/Credit hour (normally \$275/hour). Significantly discounted IU courses taught online by IU Kokomo faculty. A list of available fall options is included below.
