Payment of the scholarship stipend to the multiple semester technical school student will be payable at the successful completion of the first term or semester. If the length of time involved is a specified time such as 6 months, 4 weeks, etc., the stipend will be payable to the student upon proof of successful completion of the training.

Scholarship renewal may be offered at a later date. Check with the Administrator at Manitou Lodge 1107 and the Lodge Newsletter for possible future offerings.
